How to Use a Den Chief 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM

Learn how to best use a Den Chief to help with your den meetings.

BSA Troop Committee Challenge Training 8:00 AM – 11:00 AM

Troop Committee Training is for troop committee members, although parents and other troop leaders are invited to attend. Learn about the responsibilities of a troop committee, how the committee should be organized, and the positions to be filled on the committee.

BSA Scoutmaster / Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific Training 8:00 AM - 2:30 PM

This is the initial training for Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters (and other interested persons). This course covers the essentials of their leadership positions and provides information to help them become successful Scout leaders. Learn about working with the boys, troop organization, the patrol method, the outdoor program, the advancement program, and program planning. To be fully trained, Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters must also attend the Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills Training. The next course will be conducted at Camp Jackson in Scottsboro on November 13 – 15.

Merit Badge Counselor Training 11:00 AM – 12:00 PM

Learn all about being a merit badge counselor, from getting registered to how the merit badge process works. No charge if you only take this course. This course is a one-time requirement for all Merit Badge Counselors.

This Is Scouting 11:30 AM – 12:30 PM

This Is Scouting introduces the mission, vision, and values of the Scouting program and gives a general overview of the program. It covers Scouting in the community and how the Scouting program protects our youth. This course can also be taken online at <http://olc.scouting.org/>. If you have taken this course once, you do not need to take it again. This Is Scouting replaces the New Leaders Essentials course.
